To the heads of the local authorities of the cities and towns,

In reference to the decision of the local administration minister No. 1361/1D dated 26/4/1987 and a consequence decision No. 9213 dated 12/5/1987 relating arabizing the names of towns and villages and the public and private places according to the fourth item of the administration organization No. 496 of the year 1957 and the first item of the legislative decree No. 139 dated 6/11/1952 which includes the following:

It is band to name the private and public places like clubs, hotels, entertainment shops, bars and restaurant and the likes in foreign words or names (not Arabic).

We wish you to give full attention to this matter and ask those who are in charge of giving the licence to in account the following arrangements:

1. locating the shops which are named in foreign languages.
2. warning the owners of these shops to maximum one week of informing them under consideration of closing down and interrogating those who don't stick and charging them according to the third item from the legislation decree No. 139 date 6/./1952.
3. banning new licences for the new public and private places unless it has Arabic names.

To be looked at and inform us of the result.
